

Registered Predatory Offender

354.1 PURPOSE AND SCOPE

This policy establishes guidelines by which the Airport Police Department will address issues associated with certain offenders and how the Department will disseminate information and respond to public inquiries for information about registered offenders.

The Airport Police Department does not have permanent residents within their jurisdiction. Many of the provisions regarding registration and community notification do not affect the department. The department may receive information about a sex offender who is employed at the airport. This information will be reviewed and evaluated by the data practices designee prior to releasing it to the community.

Members of the public requesting specific information on registrants will be provided the Department of Corrections (DOC) Offender Information website.

354.2 POLICY

It is the policy of the Airport Police Department to identify and monitor registered offenders working within this jurisdiction and to take reasonable steps to address the risks those persons may pose. Department members will refer sex offenders wishing to register to the law enforcement agency of the offender's permanent residence.

354.3 DISCLOSURE TO LOCAL WELFARE AGENCY

Upon request, members may disclose the status of an individual as a predatory offender to a child protection worker who is conducting an assessment of child safety, risk of subsequent child maltreatment, and family strengths and needs under Chapter 260E (Minn. Stat. § 243.166).
